

What is a contact lens evaluation?

As a contact lens wearer additional tests are done for you to ensure that your eyes remain healthy when wearing contact lenses. The contact lens evaluation is the additional testing and time taken by the doctor and staff each year to:

- Evaluate the health of your eyes
- Review your wearing habits and lens care systems
- Take measurements of your cornea
- Discuss lens options
- Assess the contact lens fit
- Update the prescription

Isn't this part of my eye exam?

These contact lens related tests are done yearly in addition to they eye examination. These are procedures that only need to be done for contact lens wearers, not for patients who don't wear contact lenses.

Doesn't my insurance cover a contact lens evaluation?

It depends on your insurance. Most medical plans don't cover contact lens services. Some vision plans cover the contact lens fees in part or in full, but every plan is different.

How much does it cost?

It depends on the type of lenses you need and cannot be determined until you are evaluated. The cost ranges from \$61 to \$130 for a regular contact evaluation and from \$250 to \$500 for specialty contact evaluations. Such high toric, Hard contact or Keratinous lens. This evaluation is done annually.

All evaluation costs are due at the initial visit.
